



Reserve, Reactivation, Reciprocity Officer Training Program

The Reserve, Reactivation, and Reciprocity Programs are all customized to specific groups. Yet the programs are related through their delivery format. All three programs are primarily taught by means of an on-line facilitated training process.

A majority of the specific courses are taught through an interactive on-line program. You will be able to complete your coursework at times that are convenient in your daily routine.

This format will require you to have access to a computer with internet and e-mail capabilities. Most of the correspondence between instructors and students will be done on the computer. You are required to provide a useable e-mail address.

The practical portions of your defensive tactics and firearms training will be the agencies responsibility to provide. The defensive tactics system must be Human Factor Systems (formerly known as PPCT) and firearms training must be provided by a Nebraska certified firearms instructor.

All registration paperwork must have final NLETC approval by September 10, 2012. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**

The application process will take approximately 3-4 weeks to complete. Please plan accordingly.

Your On-line portion of training will begin:
September 17, 2012

You will be required to attend two on-site training sessions at the Nebraska Law Enforcement Training Center in Grand Island. These sessions will be held:

1st Session – October 17, 2012
2nd Session – November 25-26, 2012

Reciprocity Pre-Requisite: Prior Law Enforcement Certification from another state
